**Commencement:** The meeting commenced with the recitation of the Holy Quran by Mr. Abdul Rehman Siddiqui, Senior Vice President.

**President's opening remarks:** President Nasir Mansoor Qureshi, in his opening remarks, praised the Executive Committee Members for their exceptional energy, dedication, and commitment. He expressed gratitude to Allah Almighty for assembling a team driven to achieve the Chamber's core objective of fostering business growth. With optimism, he emphasized that unity and collective effort would elevate the Chamber's prestige.

**Authority to the President:** The House granted President Nasir Mansoor Qureshi blanket authority to make decisions deemed fit for the Chamber's best interest, following Vice President Nasir Mehmood Chaudhry's suggestion. This move reflects the Chamber's trust in President Qureshi's leadership and vision for the organization's growth and development.

**Renovation of Ground Floor:** A complete renovation plan, including 3D slides and renders, was presented on the projector. The House unanimously approved the renovation of the ground floor, which includes the transformation of the Munawar Mughal Hall, Senior Vice President's and Vice President's rooms, along with the corridor. This decision was made after members viewed a detailed video showcasing the proposed renovation plans.

**Secretary General's Clarification on Skardu Trip:** Secretary General Ghulam Murtaza clarified that the Executive Committee, in its 3rd meeting held on December 21, 2024, also approved expenditures related to the Skardu Tourism Summit, which took place in August 2024, as part of the Chamber's accounts approval process. Consequently, the matter stands disposed off.

Mr. Muhammad Imran suggested that such matters be deferred to the following meeting for formal inclusion in the minutes.

1. **To approve minutes of the 3<sup>rd</sup> Meeting of the Executive Committee (2024-2026) held on Saturday, 21<sup>st</sup> December 2024.**

The Minutes of the 3rd Executive Committee Meeting (2024-2026) held on Saturday, December 21, 2024, were unanimously approved.

2. **To approve accounts of the Chamber for the month of December 2024.**

The House approved the accounts for the month of December 2024 unanimously.

**Financial Assistance to MBBS Student:** Senior Vice President Abdul Rehman Siddiqui asked for the had paid Rs.11,62,500 as a semester fee for Ms. Unzila Khan, an MBBS student at Fazaia Medical College. The President clarified that generous gesture was made possible for Mr. Riaz Hussain's daughter, an ICCI member (AM-5886), requested assistance due to financial difficulties. The ICCI had saved the medical career of the student. The payment was supported by donations from Council Members:

- Mr. Muhammad Ijaz Abbasi contributed Rs.100,000.
- Mr. Abdul Rauf Alam contributed Rs.100,000.

➤ Additional funds are expected to be raised to support Unzila's education, the President added.

**Payment of Diplomatic Pass Fee:** Vice President Nasir Mehmood Chaudhry stated that the Diplomatic Pass Fee paid by the Chamber at Rs.4,000 per person on behalf of himself and President Nasir Mansoor Qureshi would be reimbursed personally.

3. **To approve the Membership Applications of the following:-**

It was suggested by the House to form of a Three-Member Committee for Membership approvals. The House unanimously decided to form a three-member committee to scrutinize and approve the membership cases to expedite the approvals on behalf of the Executive Committee. The question was raised to speed up the membership certificate to the members. Waiting for the EC approval took time.

**Background:** President Nasir Mansoor Qureshi directed the Secretary General Ghulam Murtaza to seek legal clarification on whether a committee can approve membership applications before the Executive Committee's formal ratification. The ICCI Legal Advisor, speaking via mobile speaker, confirmed that a committee can indeed approve membership applications, subject to ratification by the Executive Committee in its monthly meetings.

**Decision:** The House approved the formation of a three-member committee to approve fresh membership applications on behalf of the Executive Committee.

4. **To consider the request of member for the cancellation of Membership of M/s Shaheen Estate (AM-6487).**

The House approved the membership cancellation of M/s Shaheen Estate (AM-6487) upon their own request.

5. **To consider any other point with the permission of the Chair.**

- a) **Co-option of Executive Committee Members:** On the proposal of Mr.Tahir Ayub, the House co-opted Mian Shaukat Masud and Mr.Umair Aziz Malik into the Executive Committee to replace the delisted members Mr.Muhammad Zakria A. Zia and Mr.Umar Hussain Malik.

Mrs.Fatma Azim and Sardar Tahir Mehmood endorsed the proposal and the House unanimously approved the co-option.

- b) **Visit to Vatican City:** The House approved issuing individual visa recommendation letters to ICCI members from the Christian Community, led by Ch. Ashraf Farzand, Convener of the ICCI Interfaith Committee, to facilitate their visit to Vatican City for religious ceremonies.

President Nasir Mansoor Qureshi clarified that while ICCI did not accommodate religious tourism, members may be facilitated in their individual capacities for business or tourism. The Secretary General Ghulam Murtaza emphasized that the Chamber's sole objective is to facilitate business activities. The house agreed to issue visa recommendation letter for business individually.

Participants in the discussion included Senior Vice President Abdul Rehman Siddiqui, Mrs. Fatma Azim, Ms.Shumaila Siddiqui, Ch.Nadeem Ahmed, Mr.Muhammad Imran, Mr.Tahir Ayub, Sardar Tahir Mehmood, Mr.Atiq-ur-Rehman, Ch. Mohammad Waseem, Malik Mohsin Khalid, Mr.Muhammad Ishaq Sial, and Mr.M.Zulqurnain Abbasi.

- c) **Diplomatic Enclave Entry Passes:** The House resolved to facilitate Diplomatic Enclave Entry Passes for all Executive Members to streamline their access. President was of the view that issuing letters to all could create credibility issues and not possible to issue to thousands of the members. The house agreed to the reservations of the President but mandated him to entertain if any special case in addition to EC members.

- d) **Appointment of HR Committee Convener:** The House unanimously appointed President Nasir Mansoor Qureshi as Convener of the Standing Committee on Human Resources and include two more names of his choice.
- e) **Inclusion in the Sports Committee:** Vice President Nasir Mehmood Chaudhry raised concerns about a pending matter regarding the inclusion of a member in the Sports Committee. President Nasir Mansoor Qureshi assured the House that the necessary letter would be issued promptly.
- f) **Concerns Over Education Day Conference:** Honorable Mrs.Fatma Azim reprimanded Secretary General Ghulam Murtaza, citing his lack of involvement in the Education Day Conference and the low-profile audience as a concern. When asked for clarification, the Secretary General remained silent. The President acknowledged his limited administrative control, possibly due to his recent relocation to Islamabad.
- g) **RSVP Designation for Events:** Ms. Shumaila Siddiqui objected to the Secretary General's name being listed as RSVP on event invitations, suggesting that the concerned committee members should be given this prerogative instead. The President instructed the Secretary General to implement this change as recommended.
- h) **Approval of Free Dispensary Construction in I-10:** The House unanimously approved and applauded Mr.Faisal Muzzamal's initiative to construct a Free Dispensary on ICCI's I-10 sector plot. Mr. Muzzamal pledged to personally arrange for the availability of medicines, demonstrating his commitment to the project.
- j) **Federal Finance Minister's Visit:** The House formed a committee led by Sardar Tahir Mehmood to oversee arrangements for the visit of Federal Finance Minister Muhammad Aurangzeb and Chairman FBR on February 3, 2025.
- During the discussion, Ms.Shumaila Siddiqui emphasized the importance of adhering to time limits for speakers to ensure timely conclusion of events.
- k) **Expansion of Standing Committees:** The House approved the expansion of members in Standing Committees, increasing from 10 to 15.
- l) **Status of Committees Formed in the President's Absence:** Upon a query of Mr. Abdul Rehman Siddiqui, SVP, Mr.Nasir Mansoor Qureshi, President clarified that a legal opinion had been sought regarding committees formed in his absence. He emphasized that the Acting President could only handle day-to-day affairs, and any committee not officially notified could not convene meetings.

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**Conclusion:**

There being no other item on agenda, the meeting ended with a vote of thanks by President Nasir Mansoor Qureshi.
