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**Inauguration:** The meeting commenced with the recitation of the Holy Quran by Mr. Nair Mansoor Qureshi, the President.

**Warm Welcome and Felicitations:** The House extended a warm welcome to newly co-opted Executive Members Mian Shaukat Masood and Mr. Umair Aziz Malik. Congratulations were also given to Executive Member Mr.Muhammad Imran on the inauguration of his impressive new marquee and for hosting the Executive Body meeting with great flair.

**1. To approve minutes of the 4<sup>th</sup> Meeting of the Executive Committee (2024-2026) held on Thursday, 30<sup>th</sup> January 2025.**

The 4th Executive Committee Meeting (2024-2026) Minutes, dated January 30, 2025, were approved unanimously.

**2. To approve accounts of the Chamber for the month of January 2025.**

**Substantial reduction in expenses:** President Nasir Mansoor Qureshi informed the House about the notable decrease in the Chamber's expenditures, achieved by hosting most events in the Munawar Mughal Hall and the Board Room. This cost-saving measure was well-received by the participants.

**Rental Income Boost:** In response to Executive Member Mr.Sanaullah Khan's query, Secretary General Ghulam Murtaza announced that the Chamber's rental income has seen a significant increase, with all available spaces being fully rented out. Notably, the rental rate has been successfully negotiated to Rs.165 per square foot, substantially improving from the previous rate of Rs.125-130 per square foot. The House warmly commended this achievement.

The House unanimously approved the Accounts for the month of January 2025.

4. **To consider any other point with the permission of the Chair.**

- a. **Renovation/Digitization:** Renovation efforts are underway at the Chamber, with President Nasir Mansoor Qureshi announcing that the ground floor renovation will commence soon, with a targeted completion time of 45 days. Two quotations have been received, and the selection of the firm will be finalized once the third quotation is received.

In terms of digitization, most ERP modules are being successfully implemented. A Mobile App for membership and renewal is also in the works and will be completed within a couple of days, significantly enhancing the Chamber's service delivery.

- b. **Commendation:** Senior Vice President Abdul Rehman Siddiqui commended the digitization efforts, highlighting its efficiency in providing him with an exclusive list of rice exporters in a timely manner. He expressed his appreciation for the Secretariat staff's prompt response, attributing it to the effectiveness of the system.

He also emphasized the importance of maximum participation from Executive Members in all events, encouraging active engagement and collaboration.

- c. **Resolution against CDA:** The House unanimously adopted a resolution against the Capital Development Authority (CDA) due to its slow response to the business community's concerns. Senior Vice President Abdul Rehman Siddiqui highlighted the CDA's lethargic attitude, prompting the resolution.

Vice President Nasir Mehmood Chaudhry assured President Nasir Mansoor Qureshi of the Markets' full support over the issue. Executive Member Sardar Tahir Mehmood emphasized the need for the CDA committee to exert pressure on the authority to resolve the problems if this effort is unsuccessful, the House may initiate agitation against the Chairman.

- d. **New Membership/ Renewal Drive:** "Executive Members Mr.Zulqurnain Abbasi and Mr.Rohail Anwar Butt proposed that President Nasir Mansoor Qureshi's personal visit to the markets, accompanied by relevant Executive Members, would be beneficial for the purpose. Acting on the President's initiative, the House unanimously established the following committees comprising Executive Members of the concerned business centers, which to be provided with lists of the ICCI members for contacts. This strategic move aims to accelerate progress and achieve objectives by March 31, 2025. The discussion was enriched by valuable insights from Sardar Tahir Mehmood, Ms.Shumaila Siddiqui, Mr.Najeeb Ellahi Malik, Mr.Zulqurnain Abbasi, and Malik Mohsin Khalid on the topic.

- e. **Employees Health Insurance:** The House took a significant step toward ensuring the well-being of its employees by unanimously approving the proposal for health insurance coverage. This decision directs the Secretary General to obtain requirements from insurance companies, paving the way for a comprehensive health insurance plan.

Earlier, Executive Member Mr.Faisal Muzamal had proposed extending health insurance to all ICCI members, but Executive Member Mian Shaukat Masud expressed skepticism about finding an insurance company willing to provide coverage to all members.

- f. **Financial Assistance to MBBS student:** President Nasir Mansoor Qureshi informed the House that Rs.500,000 has been received for the specified purpose, and the remaining amount will be arranged, God willing. This update was provided in response to a query from Executive Member Ch.Muhammad Waseem.

- g. **Proposal for Chamber's Archive:** Executive Member Mian Shaukat Masud, also a former President of the Chamber, proposed creating an archive to preserve the Chamber's history for future generations. This archive would feature interviews and messages from former Presidents, highlighting their achievements and milestones during their tenures.

Building on this idea, Executive Member Mr.Atiq-ur-Rehman suggested that the achievements of all Presidents should be showcased suitably. By implementing these ideas, the Chamber can honor its legacy, provide valuable insights for future leaders, and inspire current members to strive for excellence.

- h. **Holding of Executive Committee Meetings outside the Chamber:** Executive Member Mian Shaukat Masud proposed that Executive Committee meetings should only be within the Chamber's building, but President Nasir Mansoor Qureshi countered that the Chamber has the tradition of successfully holding meetings in other locations, such as Murree. The House ultimately agreed that occasionally holding meetings outside the Chamber, at scenic or mountainous spots, would be beneficial.

- i. **Standing Committee on Human Rights:** Executive Member Ms.Shumaila Siddiqui inquired about her pending appointment as Convener of the Human Rights Committee. President Nasir Mansoor Qureshi assured her that all members are equally respected and valued and that no undue favoritism will be shown. He explained that certain matters related to Standing Committees are currently on hold,

awaiting clearance from the Council. Once received, the Chamber will promptly implement the decisions in full.

- j. Evaluation of Standing Committees Performance:** Sardar Tahir Mehmood proposed that performance of the Standing Committees should be evaluated on a regular basis by President Nasir Mansoor Qureshi himself.
- k. Refund of Security:** Executive Member Mr.Rohail Anwar Butt proposed that the security deposits received from applicants for the visit to the United States should be promptly refunded.
- l. Mr.Muhamamd Imran Minhas' appreciation:** Executive Member Imran Minhas expressed his sincere appreciation to the Chamber leadership for selecting his newly built Marquee as the venue for the Executive Committee meeting. He further extended an invitation, stating it would be an honor to host the meeting again at his venue.
- m. ICCI Dispensary:** Executive Member Mr.Faisal Muzamal proposed establishing a dispensary, citing difficulties in advancing the ICCI Dispensary project in the I-10 sector. However, Executive Member Mian Shaukat Masud countered that the Chamber's primary objective is to facilitate a favorable business environment, not to engage in philanthropic activities like an NGO. He suggested that if the Chamber still wishes to pursue this initiative, it should consider establishing a Foundation or Trust. This approach would allow the Chamber to support the dispensary project while maintaining its focus on promoting a conducive business atmosphere.

The meeting concluded with a vote of thanks, extended by President Nasir Mansoor Qureshi, as there were no further agenda items to discuss.
