Minutes of the 18th Meeting of the Executive Committee (2024–26)

The minutes of the 18th meeting of the Executive Committee, held at 4:00 PM on Thursday, 29 January 2026, are reproduced, duly signed, and circulated for your record and approval in the next EC meeting.

1. Commencement

The meeting commenced with the recitation of the Holy Quran (digital).

2. Approval of Minutes of the 17th Meeting

The Executive Committee unanimously approved the minutes of the 17th meeting of the Executive Committee (2024–26) held on Saturday, 31 December 2025. Earlier, Mr Sanaullah Khan noted that his contribution to a discussion on the new requirements for visa recommendation letters in the previous minutes had not been quoted and proposed that, in future, all contributors' names be included, even briefly. The Secretary General assured compliance and directed the concerned officer responsible for note-taking to acknowledge all speakers.

5. Leave Encashment

The House unanimously approved the HR Committee's decision to abolish the practice of leave encashment, with the objective of encouraging staff members to spend time with their families and promoting their physical and mental well-being. President Sardar Tahir Mehmood clarified that leave would be granted according to a roster system to ensure that official work remains uninterrupted. This clarification was given following a proposal by Mr Nasir Mehmood Chaudhry suggesting a turn-by-turn leave system. It was further decided that staff would be granted leave in 2026 which they did not avail in 2025 instead of encashment.

6. Any Other Point with the Permission of the Chair

The House unanimously co-opted Mirza Mohammad Ali as an Executive Member for the remaining tenure of the Executive Committee (2024–26), replacing Mr Nasir Mansoor Qureshi, who was delisted due to continuous absence from three consecutive meetings in accordance with the Articles of Association. Mr Sanaullah Khan proposed the name of Mirza Mohammad Ali for co-option. Following his co-option, Mirza Mohammad Ali expressed gratitude to the House for reposing trust in him and pledged to meet the expectations of the leadership in serving the community. Mr Abdul Rehman Siddiqui welcomed Mirza Mohammad Ali on behalf of the House and expressed confidence that the Chamber would benefit from his vast experience.

7. President's Address

President Sardar Tahir Mehmood, while distributing sector-wise membership lists, urged attendees to actively participate in the membership drive. He emphasised that increased membership would strengthen the Chamber's voice, facilitate business growth, and ensure a level playing field. He highlighted a significant increase in membership renewals — from 127 last year to 575 this year to date — and expressed his determination to achieve record-breaking new memberships and renewals during his tenure. The President urged members to promote the Chamber's registration benefits, including facilitation desks and cash discounts, to enhance registrations. He announced that Standing Committee chairmanships would be awarded generously to all aspirants to enable them to contribute effectively to the community and the Chamber. The President noted improvement in the Chamber's rating due to bold leadership initiatives and awareness sessions with senior officials of CDA, MCI, Police, District Administration, PSW, DRAP, banks, and RTO. He also highlighted the successful round-table meeting of Commercial Attachés from more than 13 countries, where participants showcased trade and investment opportunities and expressed interest in strengthening trade relations with Pakistan. He added that he effectively highlighted Pakistan's export and investment potential in his inaugural address. The President thanked the Senior Vice President, Vice President, and Executive Committee members for their full cooperation in enhancing the Chamber's service delivery.

8. Miscellaneous

Earlier, Mr Zulqurnain Abbasi appreciated the President's leadership and proposed a round of applause, which was endorsed by the House. The President welcomed Mr Malik Mohsin Khalid's proposal to allocate dedicated space for Executive Members to facilitate membership renewals from their respective areas and announced that the entire Chamber premises could be utilised for this important task. Khalid received applause from the House. Regarding the government's plan to introduce business passports, the President stated that he was unaware of detailed information when Mr Aamir Rahim Qureshi raised the matter and suggested that making Chamber membership a prerequisite could boost membership numbers. Highlighting IT initiatives, the President stressed the growing importance of Artificial Intelligence (AI) in business and expressed concern over members' limited engagement, warning that AI-driven processes will dominate future operations.

9. POS Issue


President Sardar Tahir Mehmood stated that he expects to meet FBR officials in the coming week. Mr Abdul Rehman Siddiqui raised the POS issue and urged the President to adopt a firm stance, referring to his earlier decisive position on FBR's valuation table and noting the community's expectation of similar assertiveness.


10. Dua
