5. To approve the Purchase of Camera Lens:

The House unanimously gave the approval to purchase the Camera Lens.

6. To approve Bonus for employees on the Eid-ul-Fitar:

The House unanimously approved the Bonus for employees on Eid-ul-Fitar.

7. To approve Insurance Company for the Group Insurance of the ICCI employees:

The House authorized Mr.Faisal Muzammal to seek quotations through advertisements in at least two national dailies for the purpose. At this juncture Mr. Shaukat Masood suggested that we should have to get it clarified also that whether the contractual employees are titled for such a cover or not.

8. To consider any other point with the permission of the Chair:

- a. Formation of Canton Fair delegation: The House unanimously agreed to form a delegation for participation in the Canton Fair. Mr. Imran Minhas informed that approximately 90 members had approached the Chamber expressing interest in attending the Fair. He emphasized that participation as a formal delegation would maximize benefits. Mr. Aamir Rahim Qureshi and Malik Mohsin Khalid endorsed the proposal. Earlier, when Senior Vice President Tahir Ayub proposed exemption of Visa Fee ((Rs.50,000/-) for delegates, noting that such a fee had not been charged previously, Mr. Abdul Rehman Siddiqui clarified that the fee exemption discussion in the Committee Meeting was originally pertained to the Morocco delegation, where high costs (approximately Rs. 650,000) had discouraged participation. Thereby, on the direction of the President, Secretary General Mr. Ghulam Murtaza clarified that previously the Chamber had the authority to independently decide fees for value-added services, as these were not part of the Articles of Association. However, the DGTO has now directed that all such services including visa recommendation letters, certificates of origin, and related fees must be incorporated into the Articles of Association. These amendments have been submitted for approval. Consequently, all future decisions regarding fees and charges will require approval from the Annual General Meeting (AGM).
- b. Declaration for ICCI Magazine: The House unanimously approved seeking a declaration for the Chamber's magazine from the Press Information Department, Ministry of Information and Broadcasting. This will enable eligibility for government advertisements, thereby reducing the financial burden on the Chamber. Earlier, the President highlighted that the upcoming issue will be more attractive, comprehensive, and informative, with efforts to secure increased advertisements.
- c. Shariah Compliant Bank Account: On the direction of the Chair, the Secretary General informed that the process of opening a Shariah-compliant bank account is underway and is expected to be completed within two weeks. He assured the House that the matter is being personally supervised. Mr. Sanaullah Khan also contributed his views on the subject.



- d. FM Radio License: In response to a query by Mr. Zulqurnain Abbasi, the House was informed that the vacant position of PEMRA Chairperson has now been filled, and it is expected that progress on the Chamber's FM Radio license will be expedited.
- e. Tree Plantation: The President approved participation in the Tree Plantation Campaign following a proposal by Mian Shaukat Masood. It was suggested that the Chamber collaborate with CDA at suitable locations. Mr. Imran Minhas and Mr. Abdul Rehman Siddiqui also contributed to the discussion.
- f. Markets Development: The President agreed to take up with relevant authorities the issue of the slow pace of development work in markets, as raised by Mr. Abdul Rehman Siddiqui. Senior Vice President Tahir Ayub also shared his views on the matter.
- g. FBR related matters: The President directed Mr. Abdul Rehman Siddiqui to accompany him, along with representatives of other trade bodies, in a meeting with FBR to discuss key issues concerning the business community.
- h. Ramadan Festivals: The President assigned Mr. Abdul Rehman Siddiqui to organize Ramadan festivals, assuring that he would arrange sponsorships. Mr. Imran Minhas, Mr. Aamir Rahim Qureshi, and Mr. Zulqurnain Abbasi shared their input.
- i. Iftar Dinner: The President agreed to plan an Iftar dinner of the Chamber, following a suggestion by Mr. Zulqurnain Abbasi. It was proposed that ambassadors and diplomats from Islamic countries be invited, in line with practices of other chambers.
- j. President's address: The House appreciated the President's briefing regarding membership renewals, which have exceeded 1,700 compared to 790 during the same period last year. Members applauded this significant growth. The President stated that ICCI is now being recognized as one of the most vibrant chambers, attributing this achievement to teamwork and collective efforts. He shared that during his recent meeting in Lahore with UBG leader Mr. S.M. Tanveer and LCCI President Mr. Anjum Nisar, the Chamber's performance and proactive stance on business issues were highly appreciated. He further informed the House about his correspondence with the Chairman CDA regarding irrational FAR charges and excessive transfer fees. He said that the matters were presented before the CDA Board, and the Member Finance has been tasked with submitting a report. The President said that he himself will be invited in the next Board meeting of the Authority to present the Chamber's case. He also highlighted the revision of an FBR SRO concerning Naval Enclave Housing Society, achieved through his efforts and engagement with FBR officials, thereby a delegation from Naval Enclave visited the Chamber to express gratitude. The President reaffirmed his commitment to making the tenure memorable with the cooperation of the Executive Board and urged all members to actively contribute. Mr. Zulqurnain Abbasi suggested that Executive Members should take turns visiting the Chamber to facilitate individuals seeking new memberships or renewals.



- k. At the outset, the House unanimously welcomed Mr. Umer Khayam Abbasi on his return from the Tableegh mission of 40 days duration.
- l. Conclusion: As there were no other items to be discussed, the meeting concluded with a vote of thanks to the Chair.
