Meeting Proceedings

1. Commencement

The meeting commenced with the digital recitation of the Holy Quran.

2. Confirmation of Minutes

The minutes of the 19th Meeting of the Executive Committee (2024-26), held on Friday, 27th February 2026, were presented and unanimously confirmed by the House.

3. Approval of Accounts

The Chamber's accounts for February 2026 were tabled. After review, the House unanimously approved the accounts.

4. Approval of Membership Applications

New membership applications were placed before the Committee. The House unanimously approved all applications, subject to the submission of any pending documents or required information.

5. Any Other Business, with the Permission of the Chair

a. Activation of Dormant Bank Account and Placement of Surplus Funds at Shariah-Compliant Banks

To activate the dormant account with Meezan Bank, G-8 Markaz, Islamabad, all Executive Committee members present signed the requisite documents. After due deliberation, the House unanimously decided to diversify the Chamber's surplus funds by placing them with both Meezan Bank (G-8 Markaz Branch) and Bank Islami, to ensure Shariah compliance, instead of maintaining the funds solely with Bank Islami, G-9 Markaz Branch, Islamabad.

b. Write-off of Outstanding Dues – Mr. Rao Faisal

In line with the settlement reached between ICCI and Mr. Rao Faisal, the House unanimously approved the write-off of the remaining balance amount of Rs. 1,000,000/-. Out of the total outstanding amount of Rs. 1,500,000/-, Mr. Rao Faisal had already paid Rs. 500,000/-.

The Secretary General apprised the House that the Finance Committee had offered this discount, which was accepted by Mr. Rao Faisal in full and final settlement of the account. The President then sought approval from the members, which was granted unanimously. Accordingly, the matter stands closed.

c. Committee for Real Estate Event – 7th April 2026

The House unanimously constituted a committee under the Chairmanship of the President to ensure maximum participation of ICCI members, particularly from the Real Estate and Construction sectors, in the Real Estate Event scheduled at the Convention Centre on 7th April 2026, to be addressed by the Prime Minister.

Discussion Summary:

Senior Vice President Mr. Tahir Ayub, on behalf of a senior member, suggested forwarding the names of all ICCI members to the Prime Minister's Office for invitations. However, President Sardar Tahir Mehmood clarified that only the names of interested participants would be forwarded. Invitations would be issued by the Prime Minister's Office after due security clearance, bearing specific serial numbers; therefore, indiscriminate forwarding of names would not be permissible.

Malik Mohsin Khalid proposed forming a dedicated committee from the Executive Committee to oversee participation. Mr. Aftab Gujjar suggested involving Market Presidents to ensure maximum outreach and attendance. Mr. Abdul Rehman Siddiqui recommended that the President or Senior Vice President personally engage with Market Presidents to enhance coordination.

Mian Shaukat Masood termed the event a unique opportunity and proposed that ICCI recommend the allocation of space on the outskirts of major cities for factory outlets, in line with international practices. Senior Vice President Tahir Ayub supported the idea, citing examples from the automobile and furniture sectors.

d. Shields for Executive Members – Membership Renewal Drive

The House unanimously approved awarding shields to Executive Members achieving 100% membership renewal within their respective areas. The proposal was initiated by Mr. Imran Minhas.

Mr. Rohail Anwar Butt reported near 100% renewal in G-9, while Mr. Aftab Gujjar also briefed the House on his efforts in this regard. Mr. Zulqurnain Abbasi appreciated the President's initiative and proposed cash incentives for staff, which was endorsed by Malik Mohsin Khalid.

e. Mini Exhibitions at Chamber

Mian Shaukat Masood proposed organizing regular mini-exhibitions at Basement-1 in collaboration with companies and embassies, covering sectors such as IT, computers, marble, and others. Mr. Abdul Rehman Siddiqui noted that a similar proposal had earlier been presented during discussions on the ground floor renovation budget.

f. Appreciation for the President

The House expressed its appreciation through a round of applause when Mr. Abdul Rehman Siddiqui thanked the President for effectively representing the business community in a recent meeting with the DG Tax Policy at FBR. He also commended the President's timely intervention in preventing the sealing of jewellers' shops in Jinnah Super Market by FBR officials.

g. Issuance of Quality Membership Cards

President Sardar Tahir Mehmood announced that all ICCI members would henceforth be issued high-quality "Golden Cards." This initiative followed feedback from corporate members regarding the need for improved card standards.

Vice President Irfan Chaudhry supported enhancing the quality, but suggested that there be no distinction between Corporate Members (CM) and Associate Members (AM) in card issuance. Malik Mohsin Khalid also endorsed the proposal.

h. Installation of Canopy and Renovation of Mediation Office

On a point raised by Senior Vice President Tahir Ayub regarding the long-pending installation of a canopy over the refreshment area, the House approved the immediate execution of a well-designed canopy.

The House also approved renovation work for the Mediation Office to address persistent seepage issues.

i. Reshuffling of ICCI Registration Numbers

In response to a query by Mr. Waseem Chaudhry regarding the reallocation of registration numbers of dormant or expired members, the Secretary General stated that the matter would be examined in accordance with applicable rules. The President and Senior Vice President also contributed to the discussion.

j. President's Address

President Sardar Tahir Mehmood informed the House that the Prime Minister is expected to announce incentives for the real estate sector at the Convention Centre event on 7th April 2026. Approximately 700–800 participants are expected to attend. Names, CNIC numbers, and contact details of interested members will be forwarded to the Prime Minister's Office for issuance of invitations, subject to security clearance. Invitations will be routed through referring members to ensure attendance.

He further shared that the Prime Minister's Task Force on Housing has presented comprehensive proposals to the Prime Minister, Federal Minister for Housing, Chief Secretaries of all provinces, Chairman CDA, and other senior officials. He expressed optimism that key incentives would be announced at the event, with additional measures expected in the upcoming budget.


The Task Force has also proposed special initiatives in light of the evolving Gulf situation, including attractive investment packages such as free zones modeled on international best practices (e.g., Dubai), aimed at attracting foreign currency inflows. These proposals have been finalised in consultation with the Ministries of Finance and Housing and have received unanimous endorsement.

The President urged all members to ensure maximum participation and make the event a success. He announced a follow-up meeting the next day and directed that area-wise ICCI membership lists be shared with respective Executive Members for effective coordination.


He also informed the House that the membership renewal deadline has been extended to 20th April 2026 and emphasized the importance of completing all pending renewals within the stipulated timeframe.
